Here is a general breakdown of topics by time of day: Morning, Afternoon, and Evening. Feel free to use this to guide your individual prayers or get a group together (virtually) to pray during these times.

MORNING

Pray for (and in response to) the Gathering online

Pray for personal spiritual growth during this time and for intentionality to renew and enjoy spiritual disciplines

Pray for first responders and those providing aid (EMS, fire fighters, military, and police)

Pray for those who are sick from COVID-19 and for their families. And for those who have lost loved ones.

Pray for the gospel to change hearts

Pray for those who are researching how to treat, cure, and help individuals with COVID-19

Prayers of thanks and gratitude for all God has given us through the life, death, and resurrection of Christ

AFTERNOON

Pray for our brothers and sisters in the Church, who don't have the technological means to communicate or stay connected

Pray for families to reclaim discipleship within their homes, being present with their children and listening to any questions, concerns, and anxieties they may have

Pray for doctors, nurses, and other medical professionals working in administration, custodial, or other positions at hospitals, medical offices, etc.

Pray for those who are isolated and vulnerable (elderly, homeless, those with pre-existing conditions, kids in unsafe homes)

Pray for our church to love and care for one another and our neighbors, finding creative ways to serve, even while socially distancing

Pray for those working in settings where they are at risk and any other people providing essential goods and services for our communities.

Pray for conviction where we have taken things for granted, for our sin, and for encouragement to rest in the grace of God we have received through Christ

EVENING

Pray with thanksgiving and praise for all the mercies and grace of God, even during tough times

Pray for those who are living alone and may feel lonely or isolated

Pray for governments, leaders, and city workers

Pray for those who have lost jobs or are struggling to find how to work and care for kids

Pray for the global Church to love and care for each other and our neighbors

Pray that the spread of the virus would stop and that the pandemic would end

Pray for Christ to come and make all things new
